## **Control methods and timescale**

- Only persons with appropriate training or with relevant experience allowed to use RM 15 Equipment
- Relevant training to be provided by experienced members to new members as required
- Always have at least three other person in attendance when RM 15 Equipment being used
- Data from RM15 recorder to be downloaded and processed as soon as practical after each days use
- Data to be deleted from RM 15 machine as soon as practical after downloading and processing
- Equipment to be checked after each days use and maintenance to be carried out as required
- RM 15 equipment to be securely stored when not in use
- Periods of use per operator to be limited to prevent back pain etc.
